# Full Day Camp | Ages 7 - 14\* Program Description:

This is a week-long, 9am - 4pm program.
(Offered: 8 full day weekly camps. \*Some camps allow continuing VCA students up to age 17)



Campers focus on one large project, listed below, that will take the entire week to complete. Pottery wheel and clay sculpture students will produce 2 - 10 pieces, depending on their designs. 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#### **Lunch Time**

At lunch time, we walk, "en-masse", to the Village Green, or to Young's Field (a five minute walk), time permitting; where the kids eat, play in the playground or on the tank, read a book, face paint one another, have water gun fights and/or relax under a tree. On the way back, we go for frozen yogurt at Tasty Waves. Parents pay a reduced VCA price of \$4.00 for yogurt, for an addl \$.50, children can get toppings. CHILDREN DO NOT HAVE TO PARTICIPATE IF PARENTS DON'T WANT THEIR CHILD TO HAVE FROYO!

Time and parent permitting, during the week we will also take optional mini field trips to local downtown shops, as well as VCA's Art Supply Store. Parents may provide additional money for purchases if desired. (All shops located within a 2 min. walk of the VCA).

#### Student Exhibition

The summer culminates with a gala Art Show exhibiting art work created by each student of Summer Camp Creation. We invite Parents to assist by providing food, drink and supplies to the show. Details to follow.

#### Miss Sharon's Full Day Parent Checklist:

- 1. Mandatory: Whoever is dropping off your child, MUST come inside on the first day of camp to ensure the child is set for the day. If that is impossible, please schedule a meeting with Sharon Kaufman to go through all points in advance of the first day!!!
- 2. Mandatory: If your child has any special needs, attention or behavioral issues, *Please* schedule a meeting with Sharon BEFORE the first day of camp, so we can offer them the best possible experience.
- Your child needs lunch, drinks and snack every day! Lunch and snack MUST BE NUT FREE !!!!!!NO JOKE!
- **4.** Please tell us on the first day of camp if your child is allowed to be face-painted and use colored temporary hairspray! If you don't say "no" we will assume "yes" and let them participate.
- **5.** Starting Tuesday each week, children may choose to bring water shoes, water guns, towel & bathing suit for optional water-play. (except Harry Potter weeks, which are too full of magical stuff to have water-play time.)
- **6.** Epi-Pens: PLEASE PROVIDE a lunch box and ice packs for when we go to lunch.
- 7. If a different adult is picking up your child, they MUST be on our approved sign out sheet list or they will not be released to the adult, and they MUST show ID!
- 8. Camp starts promptly at 9:00AM.
- 9. If your child is sick and cannot attend camp, please call our studio BY 8:00AM.
- **10.** Make sure that you and your child plan THE NIGHT BEFORE for the themed days. Please don't be late! The children's theme costumes are judged by the little kids promptly at 9:00AM.
- **11.** To reach your child during the campday, ALWAYS CALL THE MAIN STUDIO LINE AT 860-354-4318.
- **12.** Emergency or important calls from Miss Sharon or staff while off site:

  Please put Miss Sharons number in your phone, 203-770-2589, as that is the number she'll use to call YOU in the event of a problem when we're off-site for lunch (11;30 2:00 window).
  - a. PLEASE ANSWER that number if she calls, as it will be important!
  - **b.** \*If you MISS her call during lunch, you may call her back on the cell number until 2:00, after 2:00, return to main studio number call back.
- **13.** ALWAYS: Please leave messages regarding VCA on the VCA phone unless otherwise instructed.
- 14. THIS INCLUDES YOUR LATE ARRIVAL OR EARLY PICKUP

Disclaimer: At the beginning of the week, your children will have proper tool usage explained clearly to them. If your child misuses a tool in a way that is dangerous to the other children, you will be asked to sit next to them for the rest of the week or provide an adult sitter, or your child must leave the camp. You will not receive a refund of any kind.
